pm on Thursday, April 22nd, 2021 in the CGS/CMS Auditorium. Please enter at the CGS/CMS Auditorium Entrance.


Students will need to arrive by 5:00 pm and go directly to the CMS Band Room. Please plan to dress in nice clothes (it can be school clothes or any nice clothes).
